Issue 4: App Crashes or Glitches

If the Transflo app is not functioning properly, try updating to the latest version, restarting your phone, or reinstalling the app. Your Landstar Transflo Code is stored on the server side, so reinstalling will not lose your linked account as long as you log back in.
