The Coffee Program

For many, the primary draw of **Brewings 290 And Tidwell Houston Tx** is the coffee. The team sources single-origin beans from small farms in Central and South America, as well as Africa. They roast in small batches on-site, ensuring peak freshness. The menu is straightforward but executed with precision. - **Pastries:** Partnered with a local bakery, offering croissants, scones, and gluten-free options.

The Craft Beer and Beverage Program

As the sun sets, the focus shifts to the taps. Brewings features 16 rotating taps, with a heavy emphasis on Texas breweries. You will find staples from Saint Arnold, Karbach, and Shiner, alongside smaller craft players like Eureka Heights, Ingenious, and Brash. For those who prefer not to drink alcohol, there is a robust selection of craft sodas, kombucha, and non-alcoholic hop waters. Wine lovers are not forgotten either, with a curated list of reds, whites, and sparkling options available by the glass.

1. **Local Favorites:** The “Houston Haze” IPA from a local nano-brewery is a regular feature.
2. **Seasonal Offerings:** In the winter, look for stouts and porters; in the summer, easy-drinking wheat beers and sours.
3. **Beer Flights:** A great way to sample four different brews, served with tasting notes.
4. **Cocktail Program:** A small but mighty selection of classic cocktails using fresh ingredients.

Food Menu: Elevated Comfort Food

No great coffee shop or bar is complete without food, and Brewings delivers. The menu is designed to be approachable yet elevated. The kitchen focuses on fresh, locally sourced ingredients. Breakfast is served all day, featuring items like a breakfast taco with migas, avocado, and salsa verde, or a stacked brioche French toast with seasonal berries. For lunch and dinner, the menu leans into hearty sandwiches, salads, and shareable plates.

The “Brewings Burger” has become something of a legend in the neighborhood. It is a half-pound blend of brisket and chuck, cooked to order, topped with caramelized onions, cheddar, and a smoky bacon jam, served on a toasted potato bun. Vegetarians are well-catered for with a roasted cauliflower banh mi and a black bean quinoa bowl. The kitchen is open until 10 p.m. on weeknights and 11 p.m. on weekends, making it a reliable option for a late dinner.

The Community Impact: More Than Just a Business
