## The Biblical Foundation for Speaking Declarations

The concept of speaking declarations is deeply rooted in Scripture. From the very beginning, God spoke creation into existence. Psalm 33:6 reminds us, "By

the word of the Lord the heavens were made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth.” We are made in God’s image, and our words carry spiritual weight. Jesus Himself modeled the power of spoken declarations during His temptation in the wilderness. When Satan tempted Him, He responded not with lengthy arguments, but with clear, authoritative declarations: “It is

- **Start with Scripture:**
