An Overview of the Battlefield 3 Trophy List

The total trophy count consists of 41 Bronze, 8 Silver, 8 Gold, and the coveted Platinum trophy. The estimated time to achieve 100% completion is somewhere between 50 and 70 hours, with the majority of that time being consumed by the multiplayer grind. The difficulty rating is generally considered a 6 out of 10, primarily due to a few tricky campaign missions and the time investment required for online ranks.

A common misconception is that the single-player campaign is the hardest part. Part 1: Mastering the Single-Player Campaign Trophies

The single-player campaign in Battlefield 3 is a linear, story-driven experience. While it is shorter than some other shooters, it contains several missable trophies and difficulty-specific requirements. The most important strategy is to start your playthrough on **"Hard"** difficulty. By completing the entire campaign on Hard, you will unlock the trophies for all lower difficulties simultaneously.

Campaign Difficulty and Missable Trophies

The "Hard" difficulty in Battlefield 3 is unforgiving. You have less health, enemies are more accurate, and your HUD is significantly reduced. Patience is your greatest weapon. Use cover extensively, and never rush into an open area. One of the most challenging missions in this Battlefield 3 PS3 trophy guide is **"Going Hunting"**, where you fly a jet. This mission can be frustrating on Hard because of the precise maneuvering required. Practice the flight controls in the early sections to avoid crashing.

There are several missable trophies tied to specific actions. The most infamous is the **"In the Name of Science"** trophy, requiring you to kill an enemy with a fire extinguisher. This requires excellent aim and spatial awareness. A key tip for this trophy is to use your afterburners sparingly and focus on getting behind enemy aircraft.

Another tricky campaign trophy is **"Two for"**, which tasks you with killing two enemies with one bullet. The best place to achieve this is in the mission **"Operation Swordbreaker"**, during the alleyway section. Wait for two enemies to line up while walking through a doorway, and use a sniper rifle or a high-powered DMR. Patience is key; do not force the shot.

Efficient Campaign Walkthrough Tips

To streamline your trophy hunt, play through the entire campaign on Hard from the start. Do not worry about collectibles or specific challenge trophies on your first run. Focus solely on surviving. After you finish the story, you can use the Chapter Select feature to go back and clean up any missable trophies you missed. You can also lower the difficulty for these cleanup runs, but remember that the "Hard" difficulty trophy will only unlock if you finish the final mission on that setting. Part 2: Conquering the Cooperative Trophies

The cooperative (co-op) mode in Battlefield 3 features six unique missions that can be played with a friend or via matchmaking. These missions are separate from the campaign and offer a unique set of trophies. While they can be challenging, they are much easier to manage with a coordinated partner. Communication is vital for these trophies, so use a headset to coordinate your movements.

Essential Co-op Trophies

The most notable co-op trophies include **"Not on My Watch"**, which requires you to destroy 4 explosive objects in the mission **"Operation Exodus"** before they can be activated. You and your partner must split up and cover both sides of the map. Memorize the locations of the explosive charges to be successful.

The trophy **"Army of Two"** is earned by completing a co-op mission without either player dying. The easiest mission for this is **"Drop 'Em Like Liquid"** , which is a sniper-heavy mission. Stay at long range, take your time, and use the spotting feature to keep track of enemies. If you feel pressured, do not hesitate to fall back. Dying resets the attempt for that specific run. This is a common frustration point in any Battlefield 3 PS3 trophy guide, but patience and careful play will see you through.

Another important co-op trophy is **"Lock 'n' Load"** , which requires you to unlock all co-op weapons. This is a grind, as you need to earn a total of 250,000 co-op points. You can farm this by replaying the mission **"Exfiltration"** on Easy difficulty, as it is short and offers a good point yield. Repeat this mission with a partner, and you will unlock the weapons and the trophy in a few hours.

Part 3: The Multiplayer Grind - The Heart of the Trophy Hunt

This is the section of the Battlefield 3 PS3 trophy guide that most players dread, but it is also the most rewarding. Multiplayer trophies in Battlefield 3 require a deep understanding of the game's mechanics, class roles, and map layouts. The single most time-consuming trophy is **"Colonel Service Star 1"** , which requires you to reach rank 45 in multiplayer. This is a pure experience point (XP) grind.

Fastest Way to Rank Up in Multiplayer

- **Play on 2x XP Events:** Keep an eye on community events or double XP weekends. If these are no longer active, consider playing on high-ticket servers (servers with higher ticket counts) to extend match length and maximize your XP per session.
- **Master the Classes:** Use the Assault class for healing and reviving. Use the Support class for resupplying ammo. These actions grant significant "teamplay" points that add up quickly. A good Battlefield 3 PS3 trophy guide will always emphasize teamwork over individual performance.

Specific Multiplayer Trophy Challenges

Beyond the rank grind, there are a few specific multiplayer trophies that require precise actions:

- **"The Unknown Soldier"** : Unlock 20 unique dog tags. This is easier than it sounds. Simply play with different weapons and gadgets, and you will naturally unlock tags for kills with specific items. Focus on the "Weapon" and "Mode" specific dog tags.
- **"Gun Master"** : Win a round of Gun Master mode. This is a competitive mode where you

- **"Superiority"** : Win a round of Conquest Domination. This is a smaller, tighter version of Conquest. Stick with your squad, capture the flags in a specific order (A, B, C), and defend them. Do not spread your squad too thin.
